Statue of Liberty & Ellis Island Trip Permission and Participation

1. Catch the 7:12am train from Huntington. Everyone be in the train station waiting room by 7:00am. There are numbered parking spaces in front of the station which will cost \$5 for the day - you'll need a \$5 bill to stick in the slot.
2. Arrive at Penn Station shortly after 8am and take the subway to South Ferry, Battery Park.
3. At 9am we'd go through security at Battery park and catch the 9:30am ferry to the Statue of Liberty.
4. 10am go through security at base of Statue and view museum. Kids, and some (but not necessarily all) adults would climb the 156 steps up to the top of the pedestal (on which Lady Liberty stands). Besides a spectacular view there are also some exhibits up there.
5. Catch the 11:15 ferry for the 10 minute ride to Ellis Island.
6. View a movie on Ellis Island at 11:30 - 12.
7. Lunch at noon in the cafeteria, which is similar to the one at the Museum of Natural History - though not quite as extensive. Menu attached to kids hard copy.
8. View Ellis Island exhibits from 12:30 - around 2pm.
9. Catch the 2:15 ferry to Battery Park.
10. Take subway back to Penn Station.
11. Take the 2:52 or 3:27 train back to Huntington. We will arrive at 3:59 or 4:38 depending on which train we caught. We'll telephone the school once we are on the train.

Cost:

Kids: \$22 each. Adults: \$40 each. Buying lunch & souvenirs will be extra.
